NOTE: It is important to understand the payroll deduction process and that there are guidelines that must be followed:

- 1. Payroll deduction process takes approximately 2 months to become effective.
- 2. Only one type of service can be purchased at one time.

Section 3 - Payroll Deduction Cost

- 3. The minimum payroll deduction is \$50 per pay, however the minimum payment also depends on the amount of service and the maximum years you may take to complete the purchase before retirement (see #4).
- 4. You can take up to 5 years to purchase each year of service.
- 5. Payroll deduction must start the first pay period of the month.
