



Beneficiary Designation For Lump Sum Death Benefit

- Chapter 5505.30 of the Ohio Revised Code states that on the death of a Retirant, the Highway Patrol Retirement System (HPRS) will issue a lump-sum payment of \$5,000 to the Retirant's surviving spouse.
- If there is no surviving spouse, the payment shall be made to the beneficiary designated by the Retirant. A Retirant may designate an individual, a trust, or estate as a beneficiary.
